Making a Referral to Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE®)

Making a referral to PACE®:

Preferred Referral Method:

1. Obtain permission from person(s) being referred to provide relevant information to HVPACE Director of Outreach and Community Partnerships, Gretchen Sanewsky.
2. Call or fax referral information (see next section for brief list of recommended referral information) to Huron Valley PACE at 734-221-5124, attention Gretchen Sanewsky.

Additional Referral Method:

1. Provide PACE brochure, website, and/or Quick Facts handout, along with Director of Outreach and Community Partnerships business card, to person(s) being referred.
2. Direct them to call Gretchen Sanewsky at HVPACE 734-572-5777 ext. 228.

What are Programs of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE®)?

PACE® is a program for older adults and people over the age of 55 living with ongoing healthcare needs. A trained and experienced interdisciplinary team of healthcare professionals will provide coordinated care. PACE® provides all the care and services covered by Medicare and Medicaid, as authorized by the interdisciplinary team, as well as additional medically-necessary care and services not covered by Medicare and Medicaid. Who can join a PACE® Plan?

Refer people to join PACE if they are:

- 55 years old or older.
- Living in the service area of a PACE® organization. (See back of sheet for a list of zip codes.)
- Able to be certified by the State of Michigan as meeting the need for the nursing home level of care. (Huron Valley PACE Intake Coordinator will complete this certification.)
- Able to live safely in the community with the help of PACE® services.

Information to include in a PACE® referral:

Key information:

- Full name
- Address
- Phone number
- Date of birth

Other helpful information, if possible:

- Caregiver information (name, address, phone number)
- Information on primary health concerns
- Insurance information and status

Information can be provided in any form. For instance, if you have a facesheet or printout from your medical records including the above information, it can be faxed to Huron Valley PACE as is. *Please indicate on the phone message or fax cover sheet the name of the referring person and agency, with a contact phone number or email.*

If the participant schedules an assessment at the PACE Day Center, the Intake Coordinator may contact you with a signed release of information from the person being referred to release more complete health care records. Please contact Gretchen Sanewsky with any questions!
